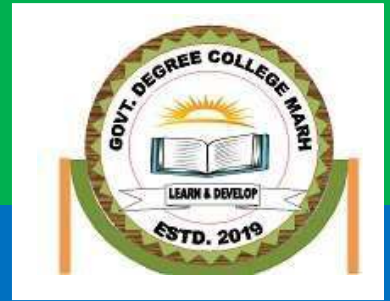

Prof. Anita Gupta, Principal, in her keynote address highlighted the importance of organising such events for the protection and conservation of environment.

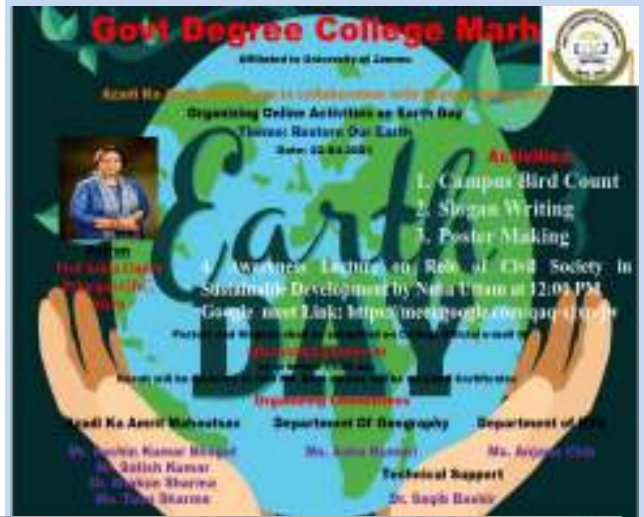
In the 1st session, an activity
